The Cleveland Council on World Affairs (CCWA) is partnering with the U.S. Department of State and World Learning to welcome student leaders from Iraq to Cleveland over July 10 – July 24, 2014. American families will have the opportunity to host a student.

IYLEP is an exchange program for accomplished students from Iraq who are proficient in English and dedicated to community involvement. The theme of the program is social entrepreneurship, as well as cultural exchange and leadership development. Students attend program activities organized by CCWA during the day, and spend evenings with their host families. **A group of five to ten American high school students will also attend the program alongside their Iraqi peers, free of charge.**

Host families provide:

- a living space for the student
- breakfast and dinner during stay
- a welcoming and open environment for the student

The program provides:

- orientation for the host family
- programming for the student, and travel to/from daily activities for the student
